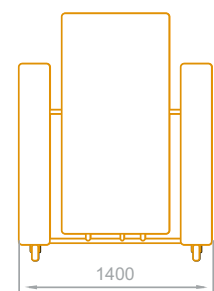
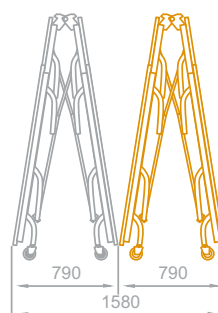
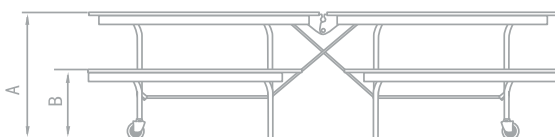
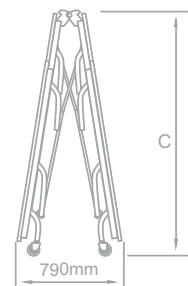
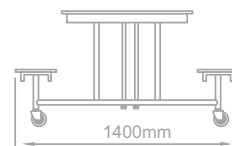
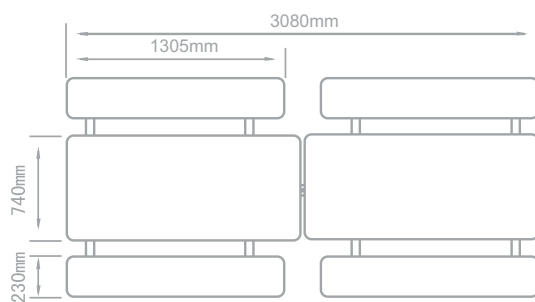
Mobile Folding Bench Unit (12-16 Seat)

The mobile folding bench seats between 12-16 (depending on age) and is easily accessible for children, through six obstacle free entrances.

- Laminated table top in a choice of Maple, Blue/Grey or Grey with tough edging and MDF core
- Choice of two heights – 685mm/375mm (table/bench) or 735mm/425mm (table/bench)
- Fits through standard height doorway (1980mm) for storage and transportation
- Grey frame
- FIRA Certified

Mobile Folding Table Operating Instructions

Operating Instructions

Moving The Folding Table



With travel lock engaged
push from the seats as shown



Do NOT push
the surface of the table



Avoid litter & obstacles
on the floor

Opening The Folding Table



With your left hand pushing down
the travel lock, push apart the stool unit with your right
hand on the middle stool



Continue opening by pressing down
with both hands on the
middle stools



Continue opening by pressing down with both
hands on the centre stools

Closing The Folding Table



Release locking bar by pressing down on the
table surface and with right hand lift clear the lock



Continue to lift using
centre stools



Using the middle stools push together to
engage travel lock

Required Maintenance.

To keep your tables operating to their optimum they must be checked regularly and have a manufacturer's annual maintenance check.

1. Regularly inspect tables for correct operation, smoothness and general stability.
2. Clean table tops according to current food service hygiene practices after each use, Exterior components of tables should be inspected for food deposits and cleaned as required. The underside of the tables should be inspected for chewing gum and other food deposits.
CAUTION:- Excessive use of water during cleaning may cause corrosion.
3. Periodic lubrication (with a food grade silicon spray) is required to pivot joints, we recommend lubrication every six months or more often if indicated by stiff operation or noise.
